
Using Near Me Video Consultations in Justice



- Near Me allows a virtual connection where an in-person visit is not possible due to the nature of a person's role or authorisation.
- Near Me is safe, secure and approved for use across the Scottish Public Sector and Prison Service.
- > Near Me is free and easy to use. You can use it anywhere at any time.



"I thought it was pretty easy to navigate... Anyone who is familiar with using MS Teams, Zoom or Webex would not find it particularly difficult ... It seems it would be a bit easier for people to access, especially if they don't have to download an app or a piece of software. The fact that it is so secure-it can't be recorded and that no personal information is kept-is reassuring...I would definitely use it again" – Independent Advocate.

Lived Experience

It was identified that a service user was needing some support and had been working with an independent advocate within the community prior to being incarcerated.

Near Me

- Due to the advocates role, they would not be allowed to travel to the prison, and rather than having a phone call they utilised Near Me via a one-time log-in made available to them for this purpose.
- This provided the service user with support in a time of need and with someone who was known to them.
- The video element added in that personal connection face-to-face that a phone call wouldn't have and was as good as an inperson visit which would have been impossible.
